## How do I pay?

### Commonwealth Home Support Program (CHSP)

Normally considered the entry point to aged care services. CHSP is provided when a specific rather than a range of services is required to support you in your home. Small out of pocket cost with a co-contribution per service.

### Home Care Packages (HCP)

Home Care packages are provided as your needs evolve and a wide range of services are required to meet your goals. Funding ranges from level 1 to level 4 with out of pocket expenses determined by a government based needs assessment.

### Fee-for-service (Private)

If you're interested in paying for home care privately, you can do so through a fee for service private arrangement.
